## *Ford Motor Company Global Scholars, Fall 2017*

The Washington Center for Internships and Academic Seminars (TWC) is offering scholarships sponsored by The Ford Motor Company to highly eligible students from universities in the following locations to participate in the TWC Academic Internship Program in Washington, D.C. during the Fall 2017 semester:

- Brazil: Sao Paolo, Camacari, Salvador
- China: Shanghai, Shenzhen, Chongqing, Nanjing
- India: Chennai, Sanand
- Mexico: Chihuahua, Estado de Mexico, San Luis Potosi, Sonora.

**Application Deadline: May 3, 2017**

### Scholarship Information

- The scholarship covers TWC program and housing fees as well as the application fee, health insurance, and SEVIS payment for the J-1 Visa.
- This program is available to students (undergraduate and graduate) enrolled in accredited universities located in the eligible locations listed.

### Program Components

Selected students will spend a semester in Washington, D.C., learning what it means to be a global scholar, including gaining professional experience in an internship in a D.C.-area organization, and an understanding what is needed to advance social issues and facilitate key partnerships in a global environment. The program has the following components:

- **Internship:** TWC will match students according to their interests and program objectives.
- **Academic Course:** All students will attend an academic course one evening per week.
- **LEAD Colloquium:** TWC enriches students' internships and academic study with weekly leadership programming all day on Fridays. Students select a **LEAD Professional Track** to focus on an area of choice. Students regularly meet for reflective **Small Group Discussions** designed for leadership training and professional development. The **Simpson-Mineta Leaders Series**, TWC's signature event, features distinguished speakers. **Civic Engagement** activities are designed to help students understand how to make a positive difference in the community. Finally, **Career Boot Camp** prepares students for their job search.

### Application Procedure

3. Submit the [Ford Motor Company Global Scholars Application by May 3, 2017](#).
4. Top applicants will be contacted for an interview with TWC by May 12, 2017.
5. After the interview process, selected candidates will be asked to complete the comprehensive TWC online application by May 19, 2017, which requests two letters of recommendation, scanned transcripts, essays and passport copy.
