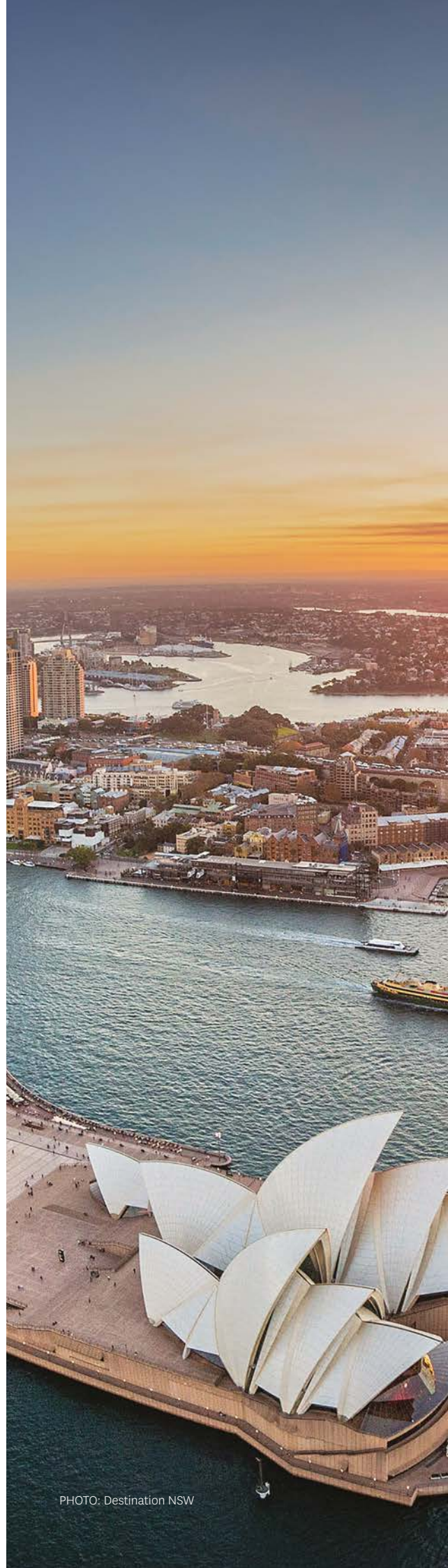

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

WHAT IS THE MINIMUM REQUIREMENT FOR A STUDY TOUR GROUP?

For our study tours, we require a minimum of 10 participants per group. For English Language and University Experience study tours, each participant has to be at least 16 years old at the start of the study tour.

HOW CAN ACCOMMODATION BE ARRANGED FOR THE GROUP?

We arrange accommodation for all study tour participants and work with you to ensure that all of your requirements are satisfied. You can stay at on-campus residential colleges, serviced apartments or with Australian host families.

WHAT ARE THE FEES FOR YOUR STUDY TOUR PROGRAMS?
